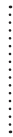




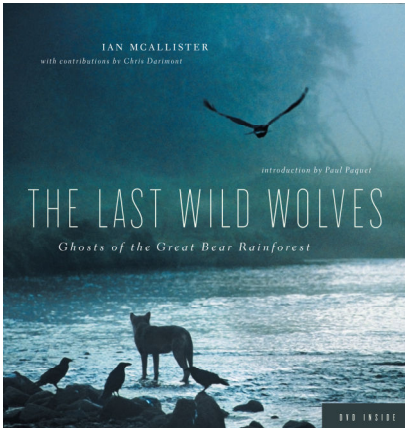

Rob Sanders, the publisher of Greystone Books: a division of D&M Publishers Inc., has sold World German rights to Ian McAllister's latest book, *The Last Wild Wolves: Ghosts of the Great Bear Rainforest*, to Anett Schwarz at Frederking & Thaler.

The Last Wild Wolves provides an intimate portrait that documents, for the first time ever, a distinct population of wolves through McAllister's firsthand observations, captivating photos, and rare video footage on DVD. In 2008, the book won the BC Booksellers' Choice Award in Honour of Bill Duthie, and was shortlisted for the Roderick Haig-Brown Regional Book Prize, the CBA Libris Award for Non-Fiction Book of the Year, and the 2007 Banff Mountain Book Award. Greystone will release a paperback edition in Fall 2009.

IAN MCALLISTER has spent the last twenty years working to conserve BC's temperate rainforest. He is the author of *The Great Bear Rainforest*, and is also an award-winning photographer and filmmaker. He lives with his family on Denny Island, BC.
